## What is an Apprenticeship?



- An Apprenticeship is **a job with learning integrated** into it, both within and outside the workplace, on and off the job. It is a way for all individuals in employment, to gain new skills and qualifications whilst working.
- Apprenticeships equip individuals with the necessary skills, knowledge and behaviours they need and for future employment and progression.
- 20% off job training included in working week but must be flexible and gain line managers approval
- An Apprenticeship is available to anyone aged from 16 to 64
- To undertake an Apprenticeship there are terms and conditions of employment,
- Apprenticeships are available from levels 2 to 7 (equivalent to a Masters Degree)
- Apprenticeships are available in 1000's of different occupations
- To undertake an Apprenticeship the Apprentice Training needs to fit in with a job role
- No tuition Fees!
- Apprenticeship vacancies within the Council these are advertised through WM Jobs


- •Levels 4,5,6,7




