Using words consistently during activities can help develop children's understanding and use of the words.

ACTIVITY IDEAS	LANGUAGE THAT CAN BE ADDED DURING THE ACTIVITY
Pop-up animals	Ready steady go Cow/pig/horse/sheep Moo/oink/ neigh/baa Gone Hello cow/ bye cow
Rings on a stick	More Ready steady go Peepo/Boo) looking through the hoop. On, on, on Off, off, off
Inset puzzle	In, in, in Out, out, out More Car, plane, boat (vocabulary on puzzle pieces)
Threading	Pull, pull, pull Whee Ready steady go Stop More
Switch toys	Ready steady go Stop More Round and round (with spinning toys) Finished

Bubbles	Blow, blow, blow Bubble Pop, pop, pop Gone More/again
Snap beads	Pull Push More Red/blue/green (colours of beads)
Stacking beakers	Up, up, up On, on, on In, in, in More Crash
